

Omnitrans Hires Shawn Brophy as Operations Director

(San Bernardino, CA) Shawn Brophy has joined Omnitrans as Director of Operations, bringing over 25 years of experience in the transit industry. He fills a vacancy left by Diane Caldera who retired in September.

Brophy's career includes time in both the private and public sectors. He was employed by MV Transportation for the past six years, most recently filling the role of Quality Assurance Director at North County Transit District in San Diego County, California.
