Omnitrans Rolls Out “OmniGo” with Free Rides

Hometown shuttle service for Chino Hills, Grand Terrace, Yucaipa

San Bernardino, CA – Getting around town is about to get easier in the communities of Chino Hills, Grand Terrace and Yucaipa with the introduction of Omnitrans’ new “OmniGo” hometown shuttle service on September 7th. Free rides will be offered through September 30th.

The new Omnitrans circulator routes feature 16-passenger buses that will operate seven days a week, serving major destinations in each community. Bus stops are spaced about every three blocks. Each OmniGo route provides connections with traditional bus routes to expand travel options throughout the Inland Empire.



“We are excited to offer improved bus service to Chino Hills, Grand Terrace and Yucaipa with our new OmniGo hometown shuttle routes,” said Director of Marketing Wendy Williams. “Omnitrans worked closely with city staff to design routes that meet the needs of each individual community.”

Chino Hills

OmniGo Route 365 serves Ayala and Chino Hills High Schools, the Chaffey College Chino campus, Chino and Chino Hills civic centers and various shopping centers. At the Chino Transit Center connections are available to Omnitrans Routes 63, 65, 68 and 83 and Orange County Transit Authority Route 758. OmniGo service frequency will be hourly on all days.

Grand Terrace

OmniGo Route 325 travels the Barton Road corridor connecting Grand Terrace with Loma Linda. Key destinations include Grand Terrace City Hall and Senior Center, Loma Linda University and Veterans Administration hospitals, the Highgrove Library and the future Grand Terrace High School. Transfers to Omnitrans Routes 2, 9 and 19 are available in Loma Linda and connections to Riverside Transit Agency Route 14 are available in Highgrove. OmniGo service frequency will be 70 minutes on all days.

Yucaipa

OmniGo Route 308/309 serves Scherer and Younglove Senior Centers, the Post Office, shopping centers, residential areas and the new Yucaipa Transit Center. There passengers can transfer to and from Route 8 and 9 and the Yucaipa OmniLink demand response service. OmniGo service frequency will be every 30 minutes Monday through Saturday and hourly on Sunday.

Following the introductory free ride period in September, Omnitrans will offer a discounted fare of 50¢ October through December. Ultimately, OmniGo fares will mirror standard Omnitrans fixed-route fares of \$1.50 for a one-way trip and \$4 for a one-day pass. Seniors and persons with disabilities ride for 60¢ per trip or \$1.85 per day. Weekly and monthly bus passes provide discounts for students, seniors and disabled customers.
