Bus Route Alternatives Open to Comments

San Bernardino, CA – Potential changes to Omnitrans bus routes will be unveiled for customer comment at area transit centers next week. Consultants will gather feedback as part of a Comprehensive Operational Analysis (COA) of Omnitrans spearheaded by San Bernardino Associated Governments (Sanbag).

Potential changes include major alignment changes on fifteen bus routes, minor alignment changes to five bus routes as well as options for several new bus routes.
